

Congratulations artists you have been accepted into the Aware 2024, With An Open Heart Exhibition. We are so thrilled to have your artwork grace the walls of the gallery and look forward to seeing you at the events that will support this exhibit.

Before you find your name, please read the following instructions as it is very important that your artwork arrives prepared for hanging and installation.

- Delivery date is Tuesday October 1, 11am – 4:45pm.
- Artwork created on 1” edge and larger does not require a frame but edges must be painted with either the art wrapping around or a color complimentary to the artwork. There are no exceptions to this stipulation. You will be asked to correct this before your artwork can be accepted into the exhibit.
- Artwork created on ¾” or smaller edge MUST have a frame. If your artwork is not framed now is the time to find one.
- NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS or other types of hanging hardware are accepted, your artworks must be wired correctly. Our hanging system is not designed for anything but wires.
- Your wire must be about 1/3 down from the top of the frame. This means for example that if your artwork is 22” x 28” it would be about 8” from the top of the frame. If your artwork is 10” x 10” it would be about 3” from the top. Get your calculators out! The wire must be tight across without any play.
- Mats and glass must be free of smudges, or any type of debris caught inside the frame.
- Frames must be free of knicks and scratches.
- All 3D art must be stable and ready to install. Jewelry should have its own necks so we can feature properly.
- Please do not attach any prices or labels or business cards. We remove all this and trash as we have our own labels and price point stickers.
- Your artwork should have your names on the back, so we know who you are. Small items such as jewelry and small 3D do not need labels, we have photos of everything.
- Be aware that our volunteers will check every incoming artwork and will request that you address any issues. We do not supply hardware or any type of tools for you to fix so come prepared.
- If you have artwork in the previous exhibit, you may pick it up at the same time you are dropping off.
- Reception is Friday October 4 and shall begin at 5 pm with speakers beginning to present at around 5:45 pm.
