- The drop off date is Tuesday January 16th, 11am 3pm. Do not drop off at the gallery, you must bring your artworks to Towne Pavilion 1 Building, 2101 Parks Avenue, Virginia Beach VA 23451. This is the building closest to the MOCA when you are getting on the freeway to go to Norfolk. I will be in the lobby accepting the artwork. Ensure it is ready to hang. (We do not transport art from the gallery to this site, you must bring it to the above address.)
- The show will be open to the public on Thursday January 18th and a reception will be announced in the next several weeks. Look out for an email from the center for that date.
- The last day of the exhibit is Monday May 13^{th,} and you will pick up your art on Tuesday May 14th between the hours of 11am 3pm. We do not store art so if you cannot pick up yourself plan with a friend that can retrieve your work.
