## **Rules:**

- This is a juried show; due to space limitations not all submitted works will be accepted.
- Entries must be submitted on line from now until Midnight, Sept. 23, 2019. (see below)
- Open to students in VB High Schools who are in grades 9-12 for the 2019-20 school year
- Each student may submit one piece
- Original subject matter only (no copies of photos, copyrighted material such as Marvel characters, sport team logos, anime, or TV/pop-culture characters)
- *All artworks must be free of copyright infringement*
- Size limit of 2D is 30" x 30" (including mat and/or frame)
- Size limit of 3D is 20" x 20" base (footprint—height can be taller)
- Installation works would generally not be acceptable—unless advance exception is arranged (email us with details at [artistsgallery@artcentervb.org](mailto:artistsgallery@artcentervb.org))
- Students provide a descriptive statement (50 words or less) to interpret the work (i.e., 1-2 sentences)
- Art must have been made in 2018 or 2019

- Artwork is encouraged to be for sale. Students receive 70% of sale price, and Gallery retains 30% commission. Works may be marked NFS (Not for Sale). *Note: any works submitted with a price will be available for sale.*
- Artworks must be presented in a clean, semi-professional manner. Two-dimensional pieces must be matted or framed with clean mats. If framed, the frames should not be scratched or damaged. Frames must have a hanging wire (no claw-hooks). If matted, please also include a backing so the art is not exposed on the back (and to facilitate hanging).
- Canvasses may be unframed, but the painting should extend on all 4 canvas sides
- Art must remain until the exhibition ends
- As a family/community gallery, artworks must be acceptable for a wide viewing audience, including children. We reserve the right to reject artwork that depicts violence, drugs, suicide, weapons, inappropriate language or other highly controversial content that the jury deems inappropriate.
- We also reserve the right to not display art that deviates considerably from the submitted image in terms of subject matter, appearance or workmanship.
